

Flu (Influenza) Vaccine Information

Please note: Our clinic will be offering the seasonal flu vaccine to our patients once these are available. Patients can book an appointment to have their flu vaccination and these will be administered while we have stock.

We will NOT be keeping a waitlist this year of patients wanting to have a flu vaccine.

Please monitor our website and our HotDoc online booking platform for up to date information regarding availability.

At this stage we have yet to receive our allocations of the Influenza vaccines.

The following people are eligible to receive free seasonal influenza vaccine:

- Infants and children aged 6 months to less than 5 years
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged six months and older
- pregnant women (at any stage of pregnancy)
- people aged 65 years and older
- people aged 6 months and older with medical conditions putting them at increased risk of severe influenza and its complications.
e.g. Diabetes, severe heart conditions, severe lung conditions, asthma, immunocompromised patients.

Please also understand that there may be times when we will exhaust our supply of flu vaccines so appointments may have to be cancelled due to lack of stock.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The preferred minimum interval between a dose of seasonal influenza vaccine and a dose of BNT162b2 or ChAdOx1-S (COVID vaccine) is 14 days.
